

LEATHER CONSOLE WITH WALNUT PANELS MGB 1968-76

'Wood and Leather' development of the popular Club design one-piece leather trimmed centre console, featuring switch and radio mountings appropriate for MGBs, MGB GTs and V8s built between 1972 and 1976. Also makes a great addition for 1968-71 MGBs and MGCs, providing a neat installation for accessory lamp switches, electric window switches, heated seat switches etc. The console is not suitable for automatic models without modification.

Beautifully crafted in hand-finished leather with burr walnut switch/radio and gear lever panels. Armrest and ashtray are not included, but may be fitted if desired. The leather console with walnut panels is available in nine colours, matching other Club leather trim products.

Most effective as part of a cockpit leather upgrade - other leather-trimmed items that may be purchased include armrest, gear lever gaiter, console extension panels and door cappings. Together with Club leather seats and a Club Classic leather panel set, the result is simply sumptuous.



Easy to fit. Secures to the under-dash reinforcement with four self tapping screws and clips, the centre is held to the tunnel by the gear lever gaiter retaining ring and four screws, while the cubby box is held to the tunnel by a single screw.



Basic hand tools required. A set of crosshead screwdrivers, plus possibly a pad and pencil to note down wiring positions on terminals of electrical equipment being transferred to the new console, if required.
